PUPIL PREMIUM - 2013-2014

The pupil premium is additional funding given by the Government to publicly fund schools in England to raise the attainment of disadvantaged pupils and close the gap between them and their peers.

Those in receipt of the Pupil Premium will fall into one of these categories:

- The pupil is eligible for Free School Meals.
- The pupil has been eligible for Free School Meals at some point in the last 6 years.
- The pupil is a child of parent(s) in the Armed Forces.

At St Teresa's School the targeted and strategic use of Pupil Premium will support us in achieving our vision that every pupil can achieve their full potential, irrespective of background or starting point. The money is used to benefit all Pupil Premium children and supports higher, as well as lower ability children by extending the provision on offer.

We currently have 88 pupils eligible for Pupil Premium - £900 per pupil. (£79,200)

Review of Pupil Premium 2014-15

KS1

The gap in performance of FSM and non-FSM is overall 0.9; compared to the national differential of 1.8. The school difference has increased from 0.6 last year to the current level of 0.9, however, overall attainment continues to rise with FSM pupils achieving an overall APS of 16.0, well above the National comparison and only 0.4 points behind the National Non-FSM group.

KS2

The gap in overall performance of FSM and non-FSM is 1.0; compared to the national differential of 2.4. With FSM children scoring 31.0 overall for Reading, Writing and Maths; compared to 32.0 for Non-FSM children. This does represent an a widening of the gap from 0.1 to the current level of 1.0, however, overall (R,W & M) attainment for FSM has risen again this year to 31.0 (equivalent to a 5c) from 30.9 the previous year. FSM children outperform their National counterparts by 4.0 overall, which is the equivalent of 2 sub-levels; in turn they outperform the National Non-FSM group by 1.6 points overall (combined R, W & M).

KS2 (Year 6): Pupil premium from last year = 20 pupils (32% of the cohort).
